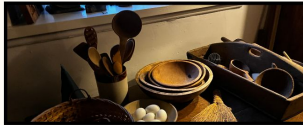
Answer: The Correct Answer is "b", 1719. Owned by the Garretson Family since 1719, it is one of the oldest historic sites in Bergen County. The home is a testimony to Dutch Culture in New Jersey, and revolutionary history in the fight for freedom against the British Crown.

Answer: The Correct Answer was "r", a jambless Oven. This was a very popular Dutch design to eliminate smoke and maximize space in small homes.

Answer: The Correct Answer is "i", the 19th Century. The second portion of the home was built nearly 150 years after the original portion, the newer portion is more reminiscent of the Victorian era.

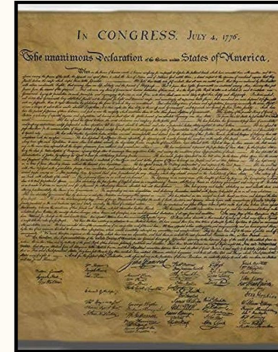
Answer: The Correct Answer is "s", Green the Backs as a comparison to their brightly red coated uniforms.

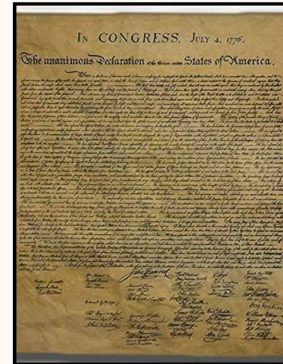

Independence Day Special Event

-The green area adjacent to the house will have some tents with picnic benches places underneath for shaded seating.

El área verde al lado de la casa tendrá algunas carpas con bancos de picnic debajo para sentarse a la sombra.

-Charcoal barbecues will be used by staff to cook typical 4th of July foods such as ribs, hamburgers, hotdogs, corn on the cob. Other foods like chips and snacks as well as beverages will can be kept on a buffet style table throughout the day.

Independence Day Special Event continued

-For children's entertainment we will provide an area for games to be played and supervised. This will include tag, jumprope, hopscotch, and hoop rolling. All 18th century related games.

Para el entretenimiento infantil dispondremos de una zona de juegos para que los niños pueden jugar pero al mismo tiempo ser supervisado. Esto incluirá lleva, saltar la cuerda, rayuela y rodar el aro publicitario. Todos los juegos correctos del siglo decimooctavo.

-In terms of pricing if we estimate 8 to 12 ounces of raw meat per adult at BBQ, and about 4 to 6 ounces per child with the expectation of 40 guests plus drinks snacks and the games. As well as the tents and benches. The total cost of the event should amount to around conservatively \$400 for all food and drinks, \$300 in tents, \$400 in tables and chairs, and games would be another \$100. In total this would be \$1200 meaning for 40 people a ticket would be \$30 each.

-En términos de precios, si estimamos de 8 a 12 onzas de carne cruda por adulto en la parrilla, y alrededor de 4 a 6 onzas por niño con la expectativa de 40 invitados más las bebidas, los snacks y los juegos. Así como carpa y las carpas y bancos. El costo total del evento debería ascender conservadoramente a unos 400 dólares para toda la comida y bebida, 300 dólares en Carpas, 400 dólares en mesas y sillas, y los juegos serían otros 100 dólares. En total, esto sería \$1200, lo que significa es que para 40 personas un boleto costaría \$30 cada uno.

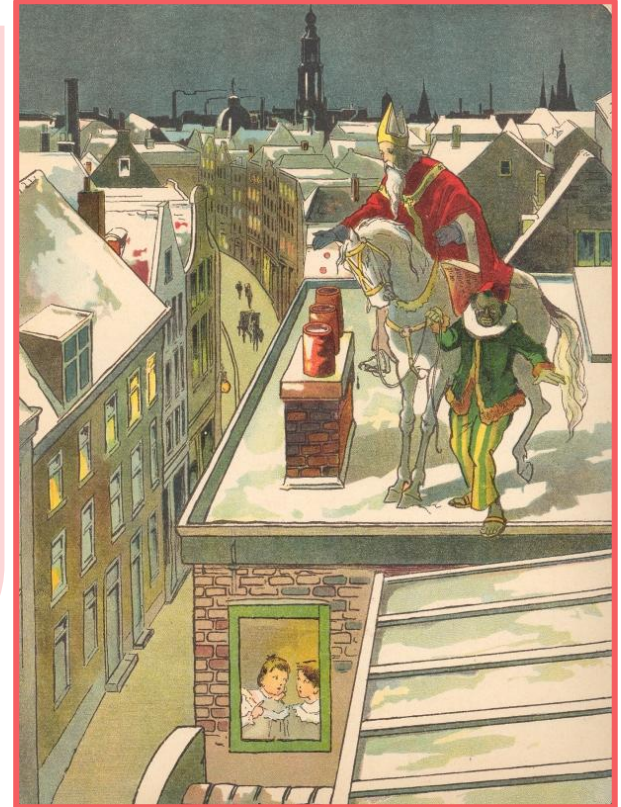

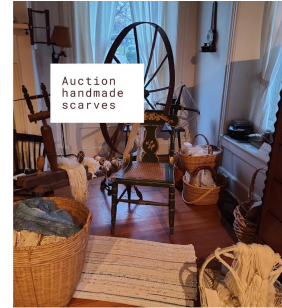

- \$300 to improve on the website, brochures and fliers
- Jamboree - \$800 for workshop instructors, decorative design, games
